

CUSD SCHOOL CONSOLIDATION AND CLOSURES

During the CUSD Board meeting on 9/23, the staff shared six recommendations for school consolidation and closures.

Meyerholz Elementary (neighborhood) and Meyerholz CLIP were explicitly mentioned in Recommendation 3 and 5:

- Recommendation 3:
 - Re-locate CLIP to the Muir School Site Effective 2022-23.
- Recommendation 5:
 - Close Meyerholz School Site Effective 2022-23.
 Current and incoming K-5 Meyerholz students (neighborhood, non-CLIP) would join Eaton Elementary School and have priority enrollment to Blue Hills Elementary School, Dilworth Elementary School, and Sedgwick Elementary School.

All proposed recommendations would be effective beginning in the 2022-23 school year. The recommendations do not affect the class size at schools, and any identified school for closure will be leased, not sold.

During the meeting on 9/23, the board held discussion; no action was taken.

October 1st ~ 7th: China's National Day

(Golden Week)

China's National Day, called 国庆节 (Guóqìngjié) in Chinese, is celebrated with great fanfare every year on October 1 as a public holiday. It is a major Chinese holiday, and grand military parades are usually held on this day every 10 years to commemorate the founding of the



People's Republic of China. The most recent parade was held on October 1, 2019, marking 70 years since the birth of the PRC.

October 10th: National Holiday of Taiwan

This holiday is always celebrated on 10 October and is the national holiday of Taiwan. It marks the start of the Wuchang Uprising of 10 October 1911. In the run up to Double Tenth Day, the square in front of

the Presidential Office Building in Taipei, the capital of Taiwan, is illuminated. There are large parades and rallies, displays of martial arts, folk dancing, and other cultural activities on the holiday. Celebrations end with a spectacular firework display over an island in the middle of the Tamsui River in Taipei.
