Happy Lunar New Year from CLIPCO!

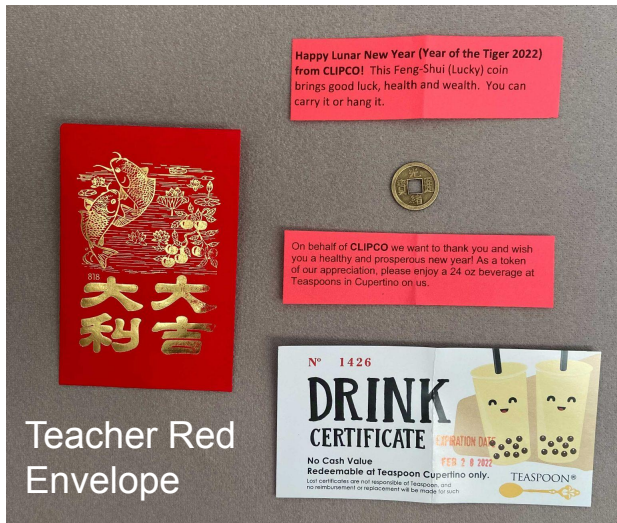
Lunar New Year is the beginning of a calendar year based on moon (lunar) cycles and is celebrated around the world. The Chinese zodiac calendar has a cycle of 12 years. Each year a Chinese zodiac animal is the symbol for the year. This year, Lunar New Year falls on February 1, 2022 and is the year of the Tiger. The new year is often celebrated with dragon dances, lion dances, red envelopes and fireworks. It ends typically with lantern festivals.

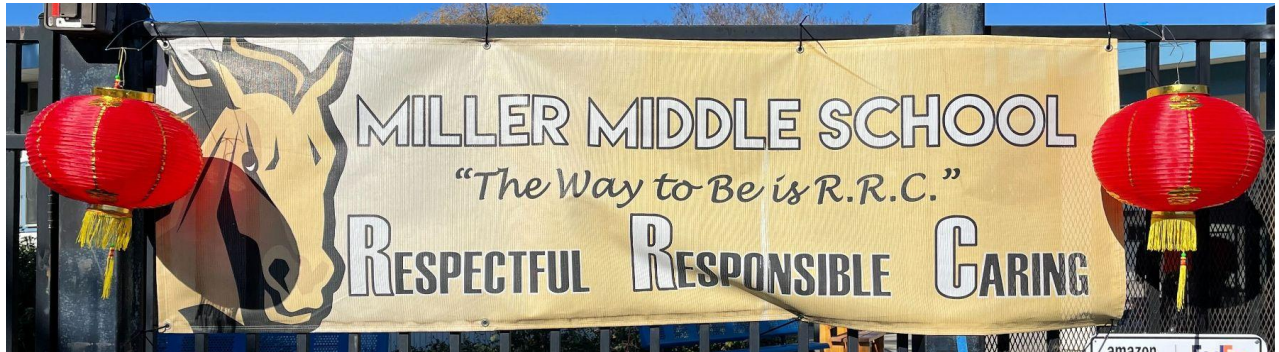

In summary for 2022-23 onward:

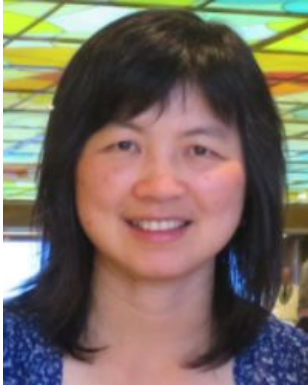
1. CLIPCO would take on the elementary PTA responsibilities, and be the primary parent fundraising body for the Muir campus.

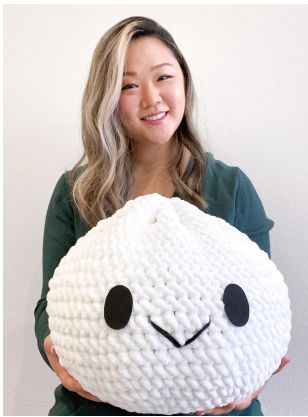
Know Your CLIP
