# CLIPCO Responsibilities & Budget at Muir (2022 - 2023)

Currently, CLIPCO is responsible for fundraising for the Mandarin-related CLIP programs, and each of Meyerholz and Miller have their own PTA boards that cover traditional programs.

#### For 2022-23 onward:

- 1. CLIPCO would take on the elementary PTA responsibilities, and be the primary parent fundraising body for the Muir campus.
- 2. CLIPCO's role at Miller is not expected to be impacted; Miller will continue to have its own PTA.

For next year's CLIPCO budget, we will be incorporating fundraising sources and program costs historically covered by the Meyerholz PTA at the new Muir campus for K-5.

Below is a summary of the current 2021-2022 budgets for both CLIPCO and the Meyerholz PTA. CLIPCO will be creating one combined budget for next year to encompass the following expenses as outlined below.




