2022-2023 CLIPCO Budget

Next year's CLIPCO budget is a significant increase from this year due to taking over the Meyerholz PTA responsibilities and increased staffing costs to support additional CLIP classes and salary raises.

The increased donation ask covers not only the existing Meyerholz PTA donation, but also additional costs faced next year. Items where CLIPCO is adding costs next year include:

- Meyerholz PTA programs
- Recess 101 (partly subsidized by the district for the next two years)
- Additional Chinese intervention IA position
- Adding two IA positions for the additional CLIP classes
- Increased instructional assistant and CLIP Art salary costs
- Increased funding for Chinese books at the elementary site
- Middle school text duplication
- Additional graduation tickets for 5th and 8th grade students

CLIPCO March 2022 Survey Results

Thank you everyone who participated in the survey. We received **131 responses** from approximately 630 CLIP families across Miller and Meyerholz.

The current responses have been very helpful, and we hope even more families will participate in the future.

Suggestions for the CLIPCO budget spending were taken in account for the recently approved 2022 - 2023 CLIP Budget. For example: **giving more budget to CLIP IAs, keeping PTA events and programs, and removal of T-shirts.**

Survey respondents would like **more communication about the transition to Muir.** To help clarify some details, we published some dates and pictures (Page 7 & 8 of May CLIPPER), and we will also publish an FAQ.
