Budget Updates - Community Events (might be low because based on Covid year and PTA covered this cost, Hospitality (snacks)/Teacher Appreciation ( lunch~\$1k and snack ~\$250)
PTA typically does not spend on lunches (expensive)
PTA on non-Covid year spends $\sim \$ 900$ for hospitality and recommends $\sim \$ 2.5 \mathrm{k}$ for staff appreciation
