## **Recess 101: Meet Coach Darleen**

Recess 101 is the leader in providing and creating a welcoming, supportive, healthy and enriching school environment that inspires change not only in the recess yard but also inside the classroom.

Coach Darleen provides a "lesson of the week" to each class grades K-5 (with our numbers, each class gets a lesson every other week). Coach Darleen presents behavioral objectives at the beginning of the lesson, and then provides immediate feedback at the end of the lesson. #### Lynbrook High School (CLIP 8th Grade Families)






