Prop 28 funding - district (or state) will fund K-3 music teacher previously funded by PTA/PTOs, will not hire Crystal Choir anymore

Additional enrollment next year

Grade 2 and 3 will each add a class

Grade 4 (current grade 3) will add more students from waitlist (current Grade 4 is 29:1)

Projecting 548 at Muir next year (494 currently), Maxed out is 582.

Six grade may expand to three classes

Currently 74 6th CLIPCO students to 84 range

Have one teacher that is on leave and probably return next year

Extra material, already budgeted at three classes Average and indirect costs increased in the district

~6.5-7% increase in average costs

4.6% to 6.61% increase in indirect costs

Budget also reflects increases from 2022-23 raises

Some numbers are still pending

Possible pay raises for next year

Insurance, CEEF donation, Tax account, Quickbook, Survey

Survey Monkey, website allocation, Jim will head DGC next year

Most of budget goes to IA

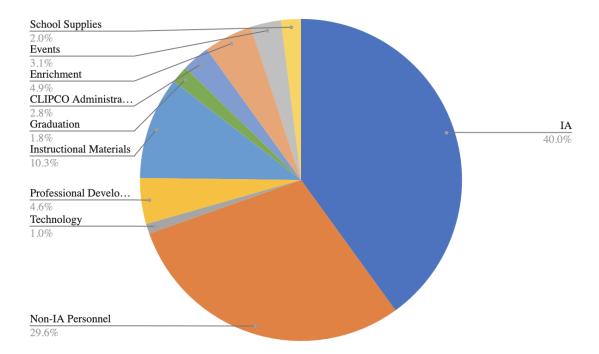
Total Budget is \$673k
