- I'd like to get better at golf



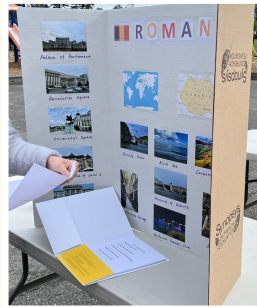

Miller News - Team Lazer Girlz

Team Lazer Girlz, six girls attending Miller Middle School in 6th grade CLIP, competed in the 2023 VEX IQ Robotics World Championship in Dallas Texas. There were 787 teams from over 40 countries competing over the span of 3 days, representing the very best robotics programs from around the world. At the World Championship, the team was able to score an average point total of 209.88 points during the division qualification matches, just 2 points short of qualifying for the division finals.

Throughout this competition season, through hard work, persistence, and focus, the team was awarded an Excellence Award, a Skills Challenge World Championship Qualification, and came within 2 points of competing in the World Championship division finals. Congratulations to Team Lazer Girlz on a very successful first season of competition.

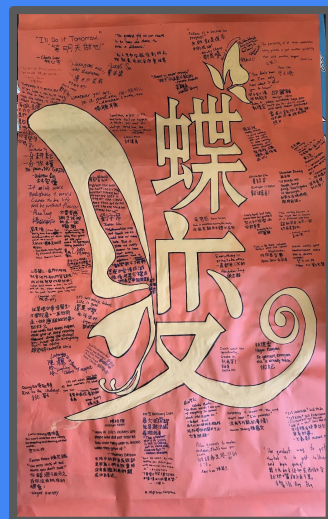

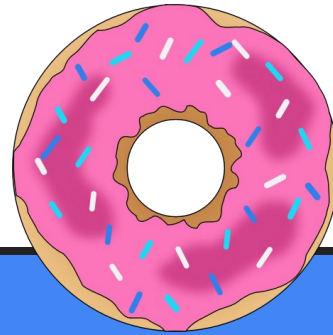
