• Power Hour

A form was sent home to Miller CLIP parents and they got a chance to submit their interests for having their child stay one hour after school at Miller M-Th for Chinese help. 57 students signed up on 9/5. The first week 39 students came on Mon, 34 kids on Tues, 38 kids on Wed, 35 kids on Thurs. The size is so large (larger than a regular class size) and kids can't get individualized support. Miller teachers request an additional classroom to support all the kids and try to keep it under 20 kids/classroom. May consider re-opening interest form for additional kids to sign up. \$66/hour, 246 hrs = \$16,236. Ms Chern 89 hrs, Mr. Kuan 65 hours, Ms Lin 92 hours.

Some discussion about Miller Power Hour vs Chinese Power Hour. Miller power hour is more like a drop in and gives time for kids to do homework. CPH has more targeted intervention and for Chinese help.

Chinese Power Hour at Miller requesting \$16,236 yearly (additional \$9036), previously approved \$7,200.

 Decorations Committee Decorations last year were done haphazardly and at random times. Julie has created a detailed spreadsheet for decorating the Muir school walls this year (5x, 12 art pieces on walls- all using paper) Initial request is \$1000. She is just taking a stab at this amount, they may or may not use up this amount. At the end of the year they can see how it went and decide how much to allocate going forward. Decorations will be led by Su Sun & Julie Siripoke.

Room parent door decor (\$20/door, 22 doors, 2x yearly) =\$880. Lalaine Chen & Christine Kuo leads. Room parents submit reimbursement and Lalaine and Christine can approve the request.

Any request for door decorations needs to be 3 weeks in advance and go to the room parent coordinators. Any request for wall decorations needs to be 3 weeks in advance to Julie/Su.

The annual decorating plan should be approved by admins.

Work with Miller for CNY gala decorations.

Discussion about where these amounts came from, the amount seems high to spend on paper. For the wall decorations Julie picked an amount she thought was reasonable and just an initial stab- could be less. For the door decorations amount - asked room parents how much they spent last year on average. Discussion about waste & sustainability - can we re-use every year? For door decorations probably not, school wide decorations could potentially consider that, have things laminated, but would have the same decorations each year. storage is also an issue. Some brought up that their kids really enjoyed seeing the surprise of new decorations and showing their parents the cool stuff around school. Question about if we can afford this? Patrick says yes.
