Mrs. Jane Lee 李老師 Room 7 - English teacher




What's the best thing about your job?





2024-2025 CUSD School Registration is coming up soon! The Priority Registration Window is January 10, 2024 through February 14, 2024. For more information, see the <u>CUSD registration webpage</u>.

- Students need to register with CUSD during Priority Registration Window.
 New families will also need to do a mandatory tour of Muir. Then during the open registration window (February 1, 2024 through February 16, 2024), they will sign up for the Muir lottery.
 - Current TK students currently attending CUSD for the 2023-2024 school year DO NOT need to complete 2024-2025 Priority Registration.
 - Current CLIP families will need to register incoming students (unless already in TK) and will need to apply for open enrollment, but do NOT need to do the CLIP tour.
