What's a special memory you have of the kids?



- Students need to register with CUSD during Priority Registration Window.
 New families will also need to do a mandatory tour of Muir. Then during the open registration window (February 1, 2024 through February 16, 2024), they will sign up for the Muir lottery.
 - Current TK students currently attending CUSD for the 2023-2024 school year DO NOT need to complete 2024-2025 Priority Registration.
 - Current CLIP families will need to register incoming students (unless already in TK) and will need to apply for open enrollment, but do NOT need to do the CLIP tour.


- Label your children's items. Water bottles, headphones, lunch containers.


